- Millions of citrus trees planted in California originated from budwood grown at Lindcove REC and tested to make sure it is free of disease.
- Lemons, limes, oranges and grapefruit are all hybrids developed from just three original citrus varieties: pummelo, mandarin and citron.
- A tiny “Cutie” or “Wonderful Halo” easy-peeling mandarin contains 30% of the recommended allowance of vitamin C.
- Flavor and ripeness of citrus can be determined by measuring the amount of sugars and the level of acid in a fruit.
